Officials

Officials Meeting - 11.10am –At the start line. Officials will be co-ordinated into event teams and allocated walkie talkies for the day where required.

Clubs are reminded they should supply two officials (minimum) to assist with officiating requirements.

Venue

The venue is called Colin Pugh SportsBowl, Blair Street, Masterton. There is parking around the venue, please be courteous. It is unlikely that you will be issued any tickets, but we do suggest you park sensibly to avoid any disappointments at the end of the day. Please be aware that any valuables you leave in your vehicles will be at your own risk.

Athlete Entry

Entry fees are \$5 per athlete. Clubs are asked to bring a cheque (made out to Wairarapa Track and Field) and pay for their athletes on the day, or you can make arrangements with Mark Harris mark@maharris.co.nz to DD the funds once the event has concluded. We will expect prompt payment if you are going to DD the funds over.

Spike Length & Type

- The spike stipulated for the Masterton track is CONE only.
- The recommended length for track races / Long Jump / Triple Jump is 7mm.
- The recommended length for High Jump /Javelin is 9mm.

Scoring

The scoring will be based upon the following point's allocation, with a maximum of 2 athletes/Club/Event
