

Wellington City Council Policy for Newtown Park under Covid Protection Framework

Kia ora,

Yesterday afternoon Wellington City Council's Chief Executive announced that **Newtown Park would become a Covid Vaccination Pass (CVP) required site at 12.01am on Friday 3rd December.**

What does this mean for you?

- Newtown Park will remain open as per normal for users of the facilities **with a Covid Vaccine Pass and visitors Under 12 years of age.**
- It is the responsibility of the key holder, event organiser / user to make sure that members of your group / event are scanned in
- When you are leaving the facility, if there is no one else using the park, we kindly request you lock the gate behind you

Over the next 24 hours we will be placing Covid Vaccine Pass signage around Newtown Park entrance points.

We are also in the process of reviewing the gate system and we will provide you further updates in this in the near future.
