COVID 19 – Delta Impact

We are now in post-Olympic period in this very different world and as many of our club's prepare to transition from winter to summer mode there are several challenges facing us all which we must consider while keeping our sport functioning effectively and safely within the Covid impact shadow.

A successful AW Road Championships was staged on the weekend under COVID L.2 protocols and the Cross Country and Road Committee, and Wainuiomata Athletics and Harrier Club led by Race Director Alan Carman are to be congratulated for a successful event. The excellent participation numbers were split across the staggered race schedule to accommodate Covid protocols. Considered and careful planning along with learnings from 2020 was the key to this successful event.

General rules to follow are as we remain in level 2 are

- > Athletics can (and should) happen at Level 2, but in a way that aligns to government guidelines
- > we want to remain good citizens, now is not the time to look at ways to 'bend' the rules!
- > Creative thinking and planning are essential
- Masks, Scan in with Covid QR codes for tracing, sanitizers, social distancing and bubbles are all part of the equation to keep our community safe while active
