Athletics Wellington Senior Team at the Athletics NZ Track & Field Championships

Congratulations to the team of 49 athletes represented Athletics Wellington at Hastings over the four days of the reformatted NZ Nationals. Several athletes were forced to withdraw though various reasons including COVID. Two Wellington athletes competed under their club colours of Wellington Scottish, including James Preston who defended his national 800m title. Other former Wellington athletes competing in other Centres colours with performances of merit were Triple Jump SM Scott Thomson 1st 14.32m (1.2), High Jump SW Keeley O'Hagan 1st 1.88m, Imogen Skelton 2nd 1.86m with both Keely and Imogen setting personal bests
