

## ROGER ROBINSON SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENT RUNNERS

CAPITAL THINKING. GLOBALLY MINDED. The Roger Robinson Scholarship for Student Runners has been established by Roger Robinson to support student runners studying at Victoria University of Wellington. Roger Robinson combined his academic and athletic interests for 35 years as Professor of English and Assistant Vice-Chancellor at the University, competing as an international runner through most of those years, and also serving as athletics stadium announcer, TV commentator, and writer.

## Criteria

- Applicant must be a New Zealand Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Applicant must be already enrolled, or intending to enrol, in full-time undergraduate study at Victoria University of Wellington
- Applicant must be a competitive runner (for the purposes of this scholarship, "runners" are defined as those running in distances from 800m and longer, provided that it is a branch of running administered by Athletics New Zealand)
- Applicant does not need to be affiliated with any specific Athletics organisation
