Event Structure	Final reporting time will be 1.15 pm. Race start time 1.30 pm – races will start in waves by grades.
Grades	Boys – Seniors, Intermediate (Under 16) and Juniors (Year 9), Girls – Seniors, Intermediate (Under 16) and Juniors (Year 9), Open Mixed Relay Teams - [Any age group] Athletes are from Co-ed schools only. Para Athletes may compete in suitable grades
Match Duration	Course will open at 12.30pm Event will conclude by 2.30pm Approximately 2.5km in length for each relay leg
Team/Squad size	Teams will consist of four members for both boys' and girls' teams. Mixed teams must have 2 boys and 2 girls.
Age Determination	The age for determining grades is 31 December 2026.

Equipment	Athletes are advised to wear footwear (Road Shoes) to compete on the course.
Use of Public Facilities	The start and finish will be in front of the Trentham Memorial Park Clubrooms for Cricket & Athletics. Some changing rooms will be available for athletes in the Clubrooms Building at Trentham Memorial Park. It is advised athletes to come changed for the event if possible. School may bring gazebos. Public toilets are available at the Park.

Code Specific – Further Information	
Composite Teams	All teams must be entered through school sports departments. Composite teams must be approved by CSW before entries close. Any approved composite teams must complete the 'Playing for another school form' to be handed to CSW at close of entries. One school sports department must take responsibility for the composite team Composite teams will not be eligible for medals.

Race Information	On arrival at Trentham Memorial Park, team managers are to report in to pick up team bib numbers. These numbers will indicate the grade, numerically coded to indicate the team number and coded to indicate the lap i.e. Lap 1 will be A, Lap 2 will be B and so on. Numbers are to be worn on the front. Numbers must be returned in your Team envelopes at the end of competition!
Medals and Certificates	Medals will be awarded to the winning senior teams and badges for the mixed, Intermediate and Junior teams.
